## Having a conversation/discussion

### Basic rules:

## - Ask for clarification:

If you don't understand what your partner says, ask for clarification so that communication is possible.

Please say that again. I didn't understand what you said.

Could you repeat that, please?

Can you speak up, please?

What exactly do you mean by...?

## - Take turns:

Give your partner the chance to react and to give an opinion.

That sounds interesting/difficult/ problematic...

*I haven't heard that before!* 

What do you think about it?

## - Use paraphrases:

If your partner doesn't understand what you say, speak slowly and paraphrase (explain in other words).

What I mean is...

What I'm trying to say is...

Let me express it another way:...

### - Speculating
